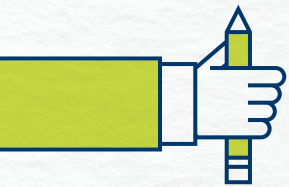
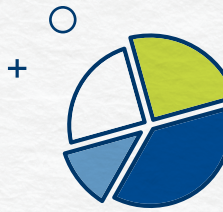

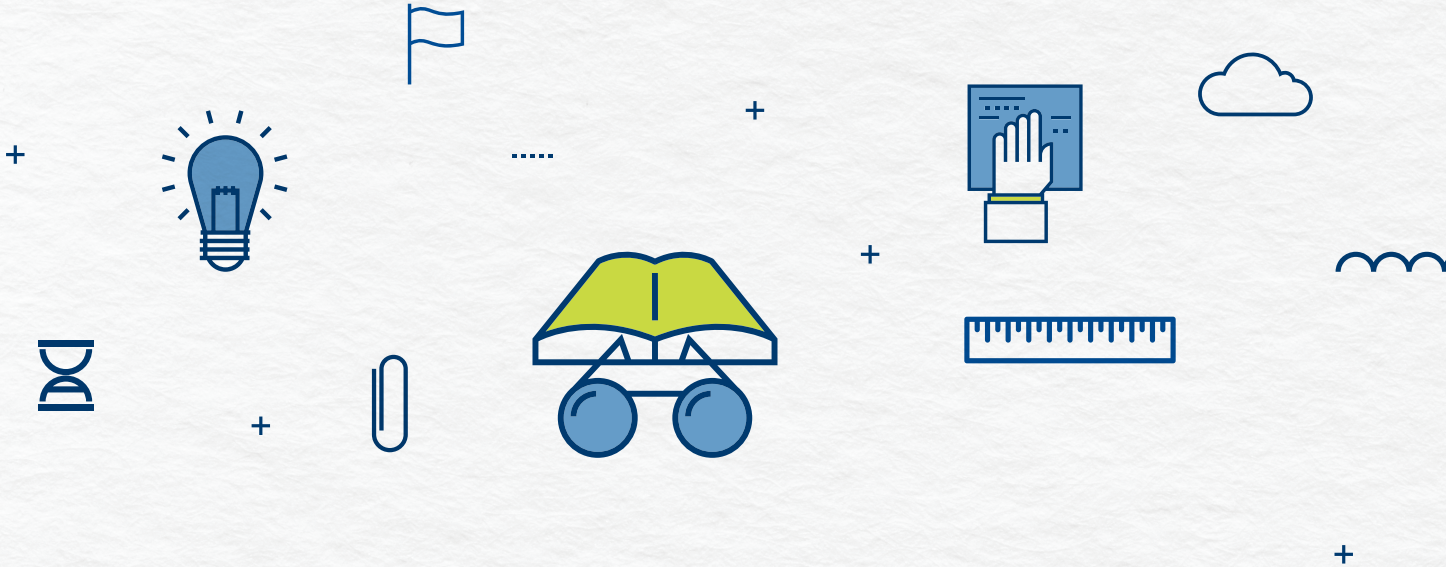
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM THIS PROGRAMME
