#### O AN OVERVIEW

Design Studies is a creative, problem-solving subject that introduces you to the fundamental principles of design. Design Studies is made up of a theoretical and practical section. The theoretical section of the subject covers design literacy (design process, design communication, visual literacy and design in a business context), the history of design, and design in a contemporary context (environmental, social and cultural context).

#### CAREER PATHS

Design Studies is a versatile subject that opens a variety of possibilities with regard to fields of study for the future. Some of these include architecture, industrial design, engineering, graphic design and fashion design.

#### WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT FROM THIS PROGRAMME

There are four disciplines you will be exposed to.

- 1. Surface design is the creation of repeat patterns; candidates will work on Adobe Illustrator for this discipline. Curro provides each candidate with an Adobe Cloud licence, which gives you access to the relevant programmes.
- 2. Environmental design includes interior design and architectural design. In this section, you will learn to create ground plans and perspective drawings, as well as model-building skills.
- 3. Product design includes everything from fashion design to light design, furniture design and more. We urge you not to choose a discipline for which you don't have access to the resources, e.g. fashion designers will need access to a sewing machine. There is a large variety of products to choose from in this section.
- 4. Visual communication design is the design of magazines, advertising materials and the like. This section is covered in every project in the exhibition phase of component 1. Candidates must advertise their product at the end of every project to put it in a business context.

#### O HOW LESSONS WILL BE CONDUCTED

It is vitally important that you manage your time effectively. Candidates are provided with video resources for every lesson, as well as booklets outlining the criteria for the projects and theory, plus a weekly schedule that outlines what needs to be completed each day. On Monday and Friday afternoons, candidates have a virtual meeting with the teacher to discuss any issues they have experienced and discover the expectations for the following week.

Design Studies learners will use specific design software, provided by the school. Please take note of the stationery requirements and the computer specifications that are needed for Design Studies.
